The ornamental design for a stringed instrument amplifier or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a stringed instrument amplifier or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a front, top, and left side perspective view.

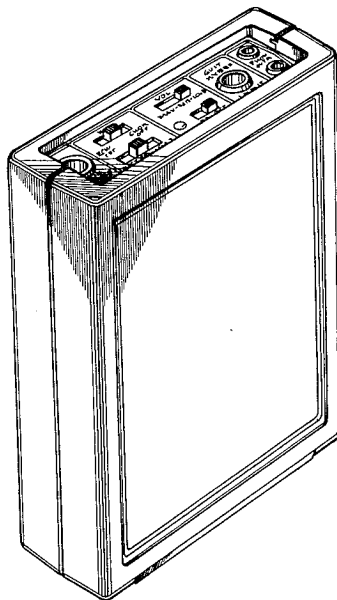

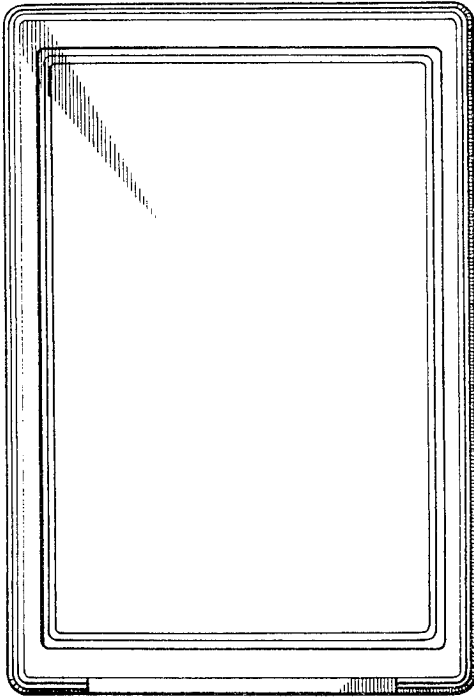

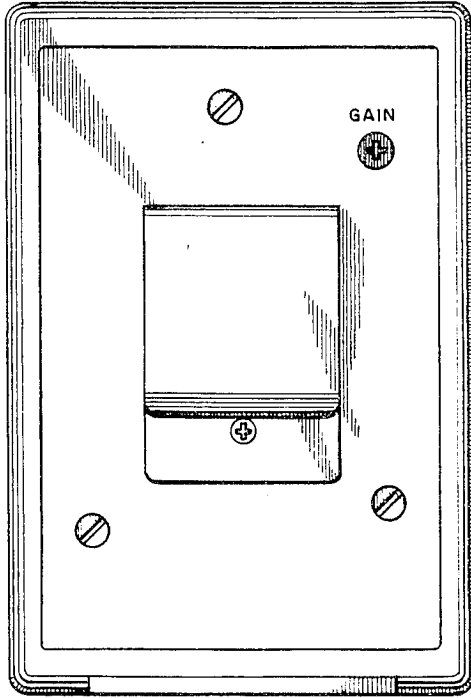

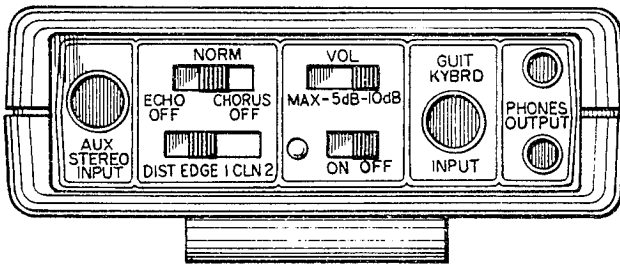

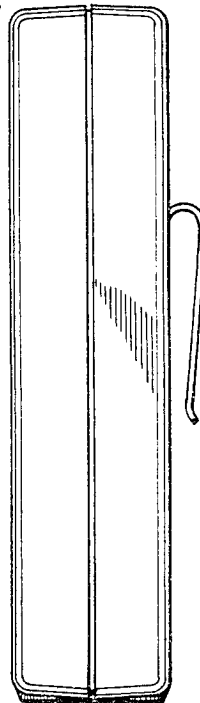
